The Stanton County Board of Commissioners met in regular session July 5, 2022. Present were Commissioners John Smith, Chris Floyd & Lonnie Brown, County Attorney David Black and County Clerk Sandy Barton. Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Minutes of June 21 were read and approved.

Road Supervisor John Schweizer met with the Board to discuss issues pertinent to his department. The Big Bow Grade project is complete. Chairman Smith signed the Cost-Plus Net Fee Agreement for the Big Bow Grade Project. The department is continuing to clean up roads after the rains.

The Board met with custodians Mitch Grover and Billy Bearce to go over their responsibilities of the county building.

The Board went over the YTD 2021 transfers for the General, Road & Bridge, Noxious Weed and Rural Fire funds. Commissioners Brown moved to leave the excess money in all the funds except General, and to move \$150,000 to the County Equipment fund. Seconded by commissioner Smith. Motion carried. Leaving the excess funds helps with decreasing the levy for 2022 taxes
