The Stanton County Board of Commissioners met in regular session on Monday, October 3, 2022. Present were Commissioners John Smith, Lonnie Brown and Chris Floyd, County Attorney Clint Floyd, and Deputy County Clerk Amber Wilkerson. Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Assistant Road Supervisor, Daniel Jeske and Operator Jon Shoemaker met with the Board to discuss the vacant Road Supervisor position. After some discussion, Jon Shoemaker was appointed the Interim Road Supervisor.

Two bids from Cleary Building Corp were presented for 1 – 60'x130' cold storage wood building for \$ 178,844 and 1 – 65'x120' cold storage wood building for \$190,452. These bids did not include doors. The Commissioners requested bids from a separate company as well as bids for metal and Morton buildings for cost comparison.

Fire Chief, Jon Shoemaker met with the Board to update them on the Fire Department. The bunker gear they purchased with the \$20,000 Cooper Clark Foundation pledge has come in. Jon has sent the paperwork to receive reimbursement. Jon found a shop to repair the bad injectors in the fire truck that's out of service and hopes to have it back soon.

Stanton County Senior Services submitted minutes from their August 16 meeting.
