December 5, 2022

The Stanton County Board of Commissioners met in regular session December 5, 2022. Present were Commissioners John Smith, Lonnie Brown & Chris Floyd, and County Clerk Sandy Barton. Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Minutes of November 21 were read and approved.

Assistant Supervisor Daniel Jeske with the road department met with the Board to discuss issues pertinent to his department. Signs are being put up on high-risk rural roads through a grant with the State. Two applications were presented for review. One application was accepted, and a wage offer will be presented to the applicant. The Board accepted a resignation letter from Mr. Jeske effective December 21. The Board thanked him for his years of service to the County.

The Board left for a holiday meal and presentation at the Museum at noon. County Attorney Clint Floyd joined the meeting at 12:30 p.m. The Board meeting resumed at the Courthouse at 1:30 p.m.

The Board met with Sheriff Jason Stewart to discuss issues within his department. Commissioner Brown moved to enter executive session at 1:30 p.m. for 15 minutes for personnel exception with the Board, County Attorney and Sheriff present, seconded by Commissioner Floyd. Motion carried. Executive session ended at 1:45 p.m. with no action taken.

The new Trak Loader for the landfill will be delivered this week with a total cost of \$400,553. ARPA funds of \$200,000 will be utilized as partial payment and Chairman Smith signed a lease-purchase agreement with Dream First Bank for \$200,553 over a 5-year period.

The Board approved the purchase of 2–30-gallon gas water heaters for the Health Department for \$3,250.00 from Ted's Plumbing.

The Hospital Board submitted minutes of their October 26 meeting.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Chairman Smith adjourned the meeting at 2:30 p.m.
