The Stanton County Board of Commissioners met for a special meeting on July 15, 2022. Present were Commissioners John smith, Chris Floyd and Lonnie Brown, County Clerk Sandy Barton and auditor Craig Hay with Hay, Rice & Associates. Chairman Smith called the meeting to order at 11:00 a.m.

Mr. Hay went over the preliminary budget for the County with the Board. After a lengthy discussion it was the consensus of the Board to not transfer money into the Bond & Interest fund from the Oil & Gas Depletion fund. The RNR rate was also discussed, which currently is at 125.656 and is down from the 2021 RNR rate of 179.553. The Board will have an RNR hearing on September 6th at 9:45 a.m. to retain the RNR of 125.656.

There being no further business to come before the Board, Chairman Smith adjourned the meeting at 12:45 p.m.
