The Stanton County Board of Commissioners met in regular session July 3, 2023. Present were Commissioners Chris Floyd, Lonnie Brown and John Smith, County Attorney Clint Floyd, and County Clerk Sandy Barton. Chairman Floyd called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m.

Chairman Floyd signed two hangar leases.
